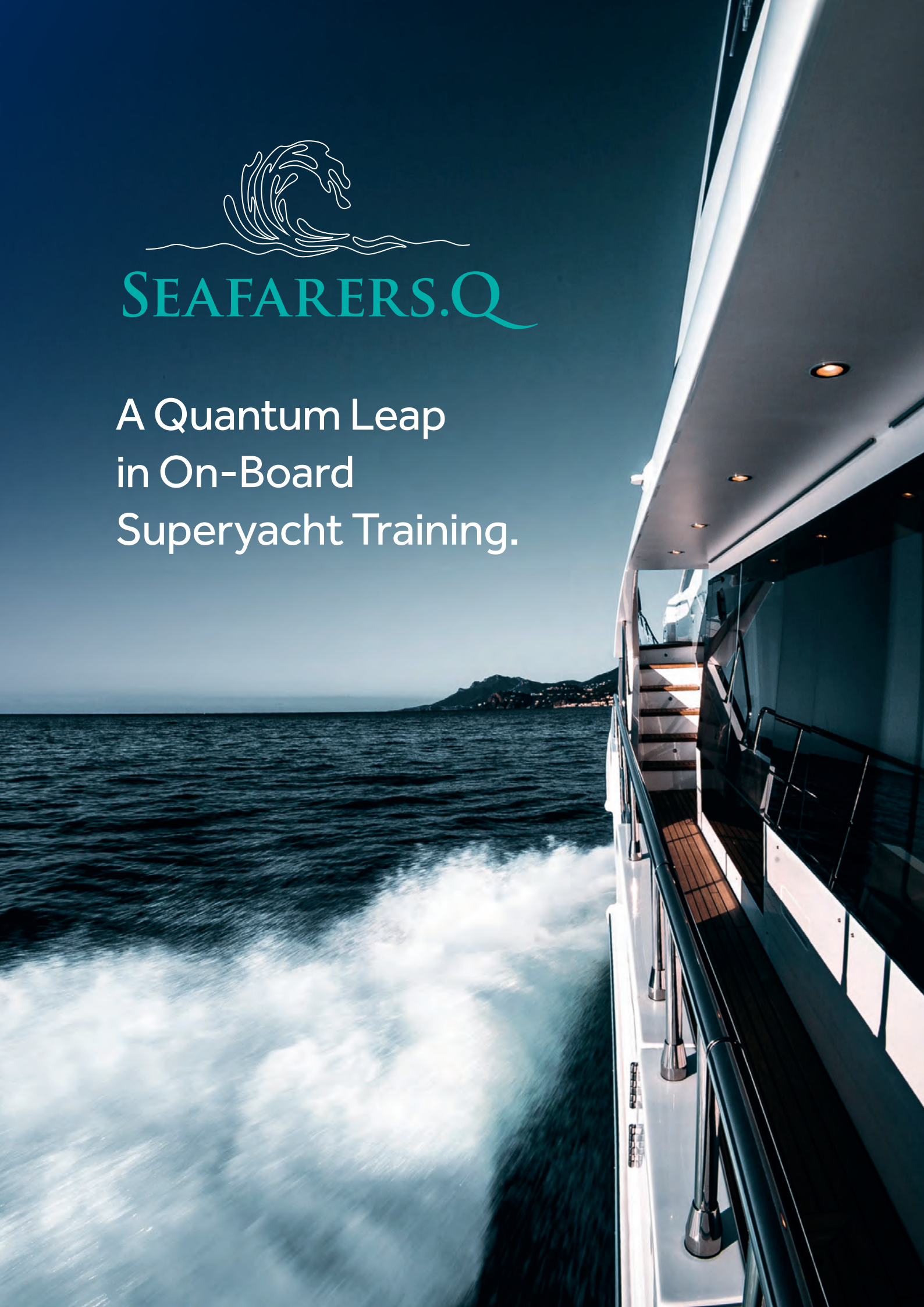

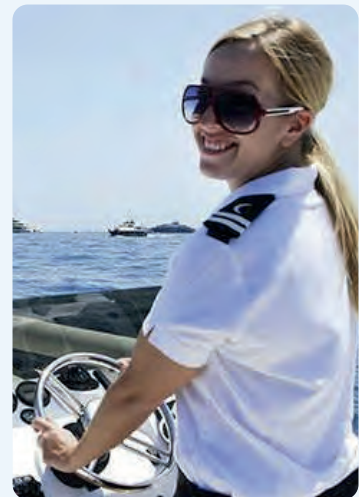

YACHT TRAINING SCHOOLS FOCUS ON TEACHING MANDATORY MCA APPROVED COURSES...
